

WEEKLY SCHEDULE – STAY ON TRACK!

- 1st week, Jan 16 Research something that interests you and keep your notes and References. Based upon your research, write a Hypothesis about something you want to observe and measure. Complete the “2012 Mary Silveira & County Science Fair Parent/Guardian & Principal Approval Form”—**Mr. Anderson must approve your hypothesis.**
- 2nd week, Jan 23 Continue your Research and if you haven’t yet, then form a Hypothesis; the “2012 Mary Silveira & County Science Fair Parent/Guardian & Principal Approval Form” is **due to Mr. Anderson by Jan. 25th**, your parents must sign this form. Put your completed form in the envelope for this in the office. When you have completed your Research & formed your Hypothesis, begin the work for the week of Jan. 30
- Jan. 27 – Approval forms signed by Mr. Anderson are returned to you**
- 3rd week, Jan 30 Design and write the Procedures for your experiment; and write your Materials list and gather your Materials. Begin your experiment if you have gathered your Materials. Finish writing your Research and References sections.
- 4th week, Feb 6 Conduct your experiment and gather your Data. Finish writing your Materials and Procedures sections. Prepare your images and/or photos (remember to note your sources for these if they aren’t you and include them in your References section). Begin typing the sections for your Display Board and thinking about how you want to do your Display Board.
- 5th week, Feb 13 Complete your experiment; decide how to display your Data and work on this section. Based upon your Data, write your Conclusion and finish any sections that you have not completed. Continue or finish typing the sections for your Display Board. Gather your materials for your Display Board and begin working on your Display Board.
- 6th week, Feb 20 **MID-WINTER BREAK**
Finish typing up sections & finish your Display Board
Work on “Abstract Project Form”

7th week, Feb. 27 Put your finishing touches on your Display Board
Mar. 2 - MES Science Fair! – Bring your Display Boards and completed “Project Abstract Form”* to the library (or the MPR—you will be notified) in the morning before school begins. Winners will be selected to move to the County Science Fair.**
